Net Surplus/Deficit

The outcome for the year ended 30 June 2023 was a deficit of \$313,427 (2022: surplus \$27,996).

Significant changes in state of affairs

While there has been no significant change to our main funding there has been considerable change to discretionary funding. Financial reserves have been depleted to help cover income shortfalls. A number of staff have completed in excess of five years of service and this has required a provision to cover a potential future Long Service Leave liability.

Principal activities

The principal activity of the Association during the course of the year was: "To provide a wide range of community services to members of the Association and to the general public." There have been no significant changes in the nature of this activity during the year.

Post Balance Sheet date events

No known matters have arisen since the end of the financial year which do or may significantly affect the Association's operations, its results or the state of its affairs in future years.

Future developments

The Association expects to maintain the present status and level of operations provided funding remains available. Our NSW Government program funding is secure until June 2025. The funding arrangement with Settlement Services International runs until June 2024.
